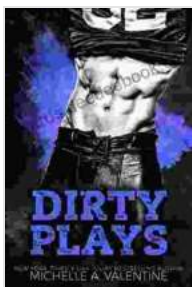


Dirty Plays in the Florida Devils Series: A Comprehensive Examination

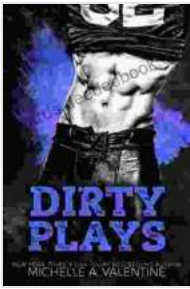
