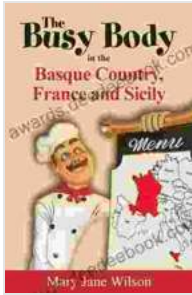
Sicily is a beautiful island with a warm climate and friendly people. I enjoyed my time there and would love to return someday.



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
